
Managing for spring baseball is a very large commitment. It will require about 8-10 hours a week of your time. This time includes but is not limited to, games, practices, field prep before and after the game, trash clean-up, and scorekeeping. There will be a “mandatory” coach’s clinic at the beginning of the season and work field days to get the fields ready for the kids. All managers/coaches are required to complete N.Y.S.C.A certification, or the Hillsborough County Coaching Certification Course, obtain a FYSA ID Card and sign the Coach’s code of conduct.

Please consider the requirements before volunteering your time to manage or coach. If you cannot fulfill the requirements there are plenty of opportunities to help the coaches during practice times. Managers/coaches will be selected by the coaching selection committee prior to the draft. You may select one assistant coach and protect their son in the draft, assuming that coach meets the requirements to coach at F.Y.B.

Coach's Code of Conduct

Coaches shall remain unconditionally supportive of the FishHawk Youth Baseball League. (FHYBL) commitment to the ideals of good sportsmanship, team play, honesty, loyalty, courage, and respect for authority. Likewise, coaches shall remain sensitive to the physical and emotional well being of the players on his/her team. In order to adhere to these doctrines the coaches agree as follows:

- Coaches will be positive role models.
 - Coaches will display and instill in their players the principals of good sportsmanship and team play.
 - Coaches will conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players.
 - Coaches will do their best to provide the players a positive experience.
 - Coaches will maintain valid certification in the NYSCA program.
1. Coaches will ensure that winning and/or losing teams do so in a manner, which exhibits respect and good sportsmanship.
 2. Coaches will treat all players, parents, spectators and league officials with respect.
 3. Coaches will provide instruction in a manner that is constructive and supportive.
 4. Coaches will not ridicule or demean players, umpires or league officials.
 5. Coaches will not tolerate behavior that endangers the health or well-being of a child.
 6. Coaches will comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policies and procedures as established or endorsed by the FHYBL.
 7. Coaches will teach the game of baseball to the best of their ability.
 8. Coaches will be drug and alcohol free while at any FHYBL athletic event.
 9. Coaches will not use any tobacco products in the dugout or on the playing field.

Coaches acknowledge the need to demonstrate fundamental proficiencies with respect to the game of baseball and first aid. Consequently, all coaches agree to attend, any skill sessions that may be required by the Board of Directors and moreover, any first aid courses that may be mandated by the Board. Your actions or inactions will greatly influence how the players and parents perceive the League, which will ultimately determine whether that child will want to participate in FHYBL in the future. Since our only purpose is to allow young people the opportunity to play organized baseball, we must cultivate them in order to exist. This is your job as a Coach. In your hands rest the future of our young people and FYB.
