COVID Return to play plan

CLEANING

1. NO EQUIPMENT is to be shared.
2. Balls will be “lysoled” before and after each session.
3. Hand sanitizer will be provided by the coaches for the participants to use.
4. Players will bring their own water bottle
5. The use of masks will be highly encouraged to players, coaches, and parents
6. Bathroom usage will be monitored by an accompanying adult
7. Surfaces at the entry and exit points will be wiped after the session is complete.

FIELD/FACILITY

1. Dugouts are the entry and exit point for the field.
2. Attendance at each practice with a log.
3. We have a COVID-19 signed waiver in place.
4. Practice times will have NO overlap.
5. An FYB Board member will be present to open and lock the field for each session.

MONITORING/COMPLIANCE

1. An FYB Board member will be present during the session and will monitor:
 - a. the session for compliance
 - b. parents for compliance
 - c. coaching staff for compliance
2. All parents & coaches will review the guidelines to return to play.
3. Adjusting to new guidelines is always difficult. Monitoring with a critical eye is important in the beginning so that players, parents, and coaches understand the level of importance. The FYB Board member will constantly roam and spot check for compliance. If compliance is not adhered to, that board member will make a verbal correction.
 - a. If a parent fails to comply, they will be asked to leave the park
 - b. If a player fails to comply, the coach should correct the situation. If the player continues, the parents will be talked to. If the lack of compliance continues, the player will be asked to leave the practice session and not be able to attend the next practice session. The Board member will be notified.
 - c. If a coach is identified as not complying, the coach will be talked to and reminded of the need for compliance
 - d. If a coach consistently fails to comply with the outlined guidelines, they will be asked to leave and cannot attend the next practice session.
 - e. If coaching staff fails to consistently comply, the session will be terminated, and the coaches will be talked to about the importance of compliance. A review of the Return to Play guidelines will be reviewed by all.

4. Any concern from a player, parent, or coach can be discussed with the coaching staff or board member who will address the concern as needed.

RETURN TO PLAY (RTP)

1. We have a COVID-19 waiver. A copy is sent with this packet
2. Only registered players will play
3. The session is practice only, no game or scrimmage will occur

SAFETY

1. Player's gear will be hung on the inside of the playing field at a minimum of 6 ft between
2. The Fishhawk Youth Sports Complex has a THOR guard to warn for lightning. If lightning occurs, practice will be terminated
3. Bleachers will NOT be used
4. Parents will bring their own chairs to sit in and be separated by a minimum of 6ft
5. Will encourage No more than 1 parent can remain around the practice area if they stay. They will be encouraged to drop off and return for pick up.
6. No team huddles
7. No player to player contact
8. Any player, parent, or coach that does not feel well will stay home. It will be highly encouraged for other family members to stay home as well.
9. No concessions will be sold
10. Player groups will be designated for each coach of no more than 6 players who will stay with that group throughout the session.
